



Sub: National Children's Assembly and Integration Camp-2015

Dear Director,

Like every year National Bal Bhavan will be organizing a week long National Children Assembly and Integration Camp Programme on the theme " My Village-My Pride" from **14th to 20th November'2015**. The detailed schedule of the programme will be sent to you shortly.

Keeping in mind the theme of the event, "My village- My pride" we would like the students participating to know and depict villages and their culture in a positive way. This is to make them relate to villages and aspire to be instrumental in bringing the positive change to the villages of the country. As always it will be a 6 days' gala event which will include activities of various kinds and enthusiastic participation is expected from the various Bal Bhavans and Bal Kendras.

The children from all Bal Bhavans and Bal Kendras are requested to send their teams for various events to be held in this 6 day program. The participation of the students in the following activities is expected:

1. Folk Music (singing or Folk Instruments, participants not more than 5 in case of group song, or max. 2 for instrument)
2. Folk Dances (representation of folk dance of your area, team event with max. no. of students being 8)
3. Street Play (Not more than 10 students for a team, Theme "Mera Adarsh Gaon")
4. Puppetry Art (Max. team members 4, Theme- "Folk tales from villages")
5. Village Panchayat/Samiti- 1 student for depiction of village issues and solutions, students will be asked to be part of dramatic representation on the same and will be made part of various teams.
6. Working Models on 'Innovative use of energy resources' in villages. One participant from a centre.

7. Discussions on Village Scenario and future planning/ technology and villages. One participant from a centre.

All the activities are divided in two groups:

1. Show your skill – this includes Folk music/song, Folk Dance, Street Play and Puppetry art.
2. Scratch your brains – Working Models, Village Panchayats- Samiti and Discussions.

Each Bal Bhavans /Bal Kendra can send one entry in each segment. Prior registration and details (small written description) of the entry in both categories is needed. A scrutiny of entries will be done at the NBB and selection will be done accordingly. Decision of NBB team will be final for the same. Number of participating children will vary according to the chosen activities but maximum participation should not exceed 10 numbers of children.

Details of each event and registration format will be sent later. It is expected that you identify the activities you would like to participate and send us a letter of interest for the same by 20.10.2015.

In case the Bal Bhavans are not sending any team participation then sending 5 children as per the norms is required along with the escorts. The team has to report at National Bal Bhavan positively on 13th November'2015 and may leave Delhi on 21st November'2015.

TA/DA for the children and 1 escort (2 escorts in case of mixed group) will be settled as per Bal Bhavan norms which are as follows:

- i) 2nd class sleeper for to & fro journey will be paid.
- ii) Bus/Auto fare from destination to railway station/point of bus transport (No taxi or deluxe bus will be permitted).
- iii) DA will be admissible @ Rs. 125/- per child and @ Rs. 175/- per escorts.

The percentage of DA is allowed:

- iv) For more than 6 hours but not exceeding 12 hours 70%
- v) For more than 12 hours – full DA i.e. 100%
- vi) DA hours will be counted from round the clock.

For participants for North Eastern Bal Bhavans, travel by Air India flight up to Kolkata and back is allowed. Remaining journey from Kolkata to Delhi and back, TA admissible is as per details given above.

Kindly make sure that the following instructions are followed while sending the children and deputing the escorts.

1. For administrative reasons, only staff of Bal Bhavan/Kendra are permitted to escort the children. Parents are not permitted to escort children.
2. The participating children should not carry any valuables with them.
3. The participants (children) along with the escorts must report to National Bal Bhavan on 13th November'2015 and may leave Delhi on 21st November'2015.
4. The children and the escort(s) should carry identity card issued by their Bal Bhavan.
5. Registration of the participants to be done through enclosed Registration Form.
